
World of Pies

Discussion Guide

- **3.** How would you characterize the relationship between Carl and Christina? What does Roxanne learn about relationships from her parents?
- **4.** Why does Roxanne fear the arrival of her baby sister? What effect does the large age gap have on their relationship?
- 5. How does Stolz keep the father's presence felt in the chapters subsequent to his death at an early age?
- **6.** What are the gifts of small-town life? What are the strictures?
- 7. What motivates Roxanne's interaction with Tommy at the end of "Solace"? Name three plot threads in the story that have a common link.

- 8. Aunt Ruthie is a source of humor in the book; what events gave you a more balanced view of her and her motivations?
- 9. Why does Roxanne have such a hard time deciding to have a baby when she comes from such a happy home herself?
- 10. What is the cultural center of Annette, Texas? What part does this venue play in the book's progress?
- 11. Why is small-town life in the sixties so food-focused? What memories did the food in the book stimulate in you?
- 12. What is Roxanne's biggest character flaw? What is her greatest strength?
- **13.** Why did Stolz set all of the stories/chapters in the summertime?
